The Wakaw Lake Stewardship Group formed in the winter of 2009 with the intention of establishing a recommending body for their councils and area residents on ways to better manage and sustain Wakaw Lake. The group is comprised of 3 municipalities, a regional park and a special interest community group: the R.M. of Hoodoo, Town of Wakaw, Resort Village of Wakaw Lake, the Wakaw Lake Regional Park and the Property Owners of Wakaw Lake (POWL). All members of the group are dedicated to protect and preserve the quality, longevity, and enjoyment of Wakaw Lake.

The group expressed their dedication to this initiative by signing a Memorandum of Understanding in July 2010 that identifies their priorities, willingness to work as a collective, and a common line of action. The group is enthusiastically committed to developing a Lakeshore Development Study (including water quality testing), meeting on a monthly basis to determine policies and strategies to better preserve and manage issues concerning the lake. The Wakaw Lake Stewardship Group believes that this project will be a valuable learning opportunity, raising awareness of the importance of water and lakeshore preservation for municipalities, organizations, and residents in the area.
